Palestinian Political Leader and
Legislative Council Member

Ahmad Sa'adat is a Palestinian political leader, the General Secretary of the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine and a member of the Palestinian Legislative Council. He is also one of 4,800 Palestinian political prisoners. His over three years of isolation helped to spark the April-May 2012 hunger strike, in which thousands of prisoners joined, winning an agreement to end isolation. Sa'adat is sentenced to thirty years in prison, although the charges against him are all related to his political work "incitement," and membership in a prohibited organization - his own political party.
