AYMAN NASSER

Advocate & Human Rights Defender Prisoners' Rights Activist Behind Bars

Ayman Nasser is the legal unit coordinator with Ad-dameer Prisoner Support and Human Rights Organization, an activist for prisoners' rights, and a member of the municipal council of Saffa, his home village. After 39 days of interrogation, blindfolded and shackled for up to 10 hours at a time, he was convicted in a military court of political activities: participating in the annual Prisoner's Day rally in 2011 and 2012, joining the annual memorial rally for an assassinated Palestinian leader, and participating in solidarity activities during prisoners' hunger strikes. He was finally released in October 2013. On September 18, 2014, 15 soldiers raided his home and held his family at gunpoint while arresting Ayman. Ayman has not been charged and remains once again detained by the Israeli military, in violation of international law and standards regarding the protection of human rights defenders.
